- \* Gretsch 1960s round badge drum kit-grey (kick drum has the BJM logo on it)
- \* Fender Bassman 1960s blackface head (the 'B' is blackened out so that it says "assman")
- \* 1970s silverface Fender Twin amp
- \* 2 Fender Twin reissue black face amps (one has a sticker on the front that reads "Masonic")
- \* Red Rickenbacker bass
- \* 12-string 1960s Gibson ES-335 guitar with re-laminated/re-glued headstock: easily identifiable
- \* Vox Cheetah guitar- maroon
- \* Vox 12-string Phantom guitar-- black and white
- \* Vox 12-string Starstreamer guitar- sunburst teardrop shape
- \* Rickenbacker 12-string 360 guitar- black and white re-glued
- \* Epiphone 6-string- tobacco burst hollow body guitar
- \* purple colorsound wah-wah pedal
- \* line 6 delay modeler pedal
- \* menotone "dirty blonde" over drive pedal
- \* mxr dual distortion box
- \* dan echo danelectro delay pedal
- \* boss digital delay/reverb box
- \* 3 boss tuner pedals
- \* dunlop volumepedal
- \* morley a/b/ box w/playboy bunny sticker between the switches
- \* boss 303 dr. sample

All the guitar cases have our band stickers.
